1	<p style="text-align: center;">NAIROBI ↓ LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport on a morning flight, you'll be met and after briefing by our airport representative, commence the safari driving to the Great Rift Valley and on to Lake Nakuru National Park. ▪ Lunch at the Lodge. Then go for afternoon game drive. ▪ Lake Nakuru National Park is dominated by a gentle undulating terrain with open bush and woodlands, typical of the dry rift valley vegetation. Twenty seven percent (27%) of the park is composed of the Lake Nakuru waters. ▪ It is famous as an ornithological paradise where you will be able to see millions of lesser and greater flamingoes, which form a beautiful pink color on the Lake Shores. There are also plenty of other aquatic birds. The park was also declared a Rhino sanctuary in 1983. ▪ The Rhino stocking programme received White Rhinos from South Africa. Currently the sanctuary has approximately 45 Black and 31 White Rhinoceros. It is the place where you are guaranteed to see both the rhinos in their natural habitat. The Park is also rich in other plains game. ▪ Return to the lodge in the late evening. ▪ Dinner and overnight at Sarova Lion Hill Lodge or similar. 	
2	<p style="text-align: center;">LAKE NAKURU ↓ MASAI MARA GAME RESERVE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ After early breakfast depart for a short game drive en-route to Maasai Mara National Reserve. ▪ Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch. Then go for an afternoon game viewing drive. ▪ The Maasai Mara is Kenya's finest and most outstanding wildlife sanctuary where gentle rolling grassland ensures animals are never out of sight. The climate is gentle, rarely too hot and well spread rainfall year round. This enormous reserve is actually part of the vast Serengeti plains famously known for its spectacular great wildebeest's migration and is home of the Big Five: Lion, Elephant, Leopard, Buffalo and Rhino. ▪ Later in the evening, return to the Lodge. Dinner and overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge or similar 	
3	<p style="text-align: center;">MASAI MARA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ After breakfast, depart with picnic lunch box for a full day game drive in search of the big five. The search for great predators and perhaps even cubs continues today during extensive game drives. ▪ On the plains are enormous herds of grazing animals plus the elusive Cheetah and 	

		<p>leopard hiding amidst acacia boughs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ During your stay, you will also have an optional opportunity to visit a village of the Maasai people to witness the singing and dancing that are part of their daily lives and sacred rituals. A glimpse into their homes and social structure is a poignant experience. ▪ Dinner and overnight at Mara Sopa Lodge or similar.
4	<p>MASAI MARA ↓ NAIROBI</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Early morning tea / coffee or Hot chocolate, then depart for a morning game drive. ▪ Then return to the Lodge for a full breakfast before departing back to Nairobi. ▪ Lunch at the famous Carnivore Restaurant. ▪ Two hours prior to departure time, transferred to the Airport to check in for your return flight.
