1	NAIROBI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport by afternoon flight, you'll be met and transferred to the City Hotel.</li> <li>Dinner and overnight at Silver Springs Hotel or similar.</li> </ul>	
2	NAIROBI ↓ SAMBURU	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After early breakfast, pick up at the Hotel and depart Nairobi driving across the Kikuyu Farm lands Northwards to Samburu Game Reserve.</li> <li>Arrive at Samburu Simba Lodge in time for lunch.</li> <li>After lunch and short rest, enjoy afternoon game viewing drive.</li> </ul> <p>Samburu National Reserve is worth a visit. It is situated on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River in Kenya. This means plenty of water, trees and shade to attract wildlife like Elephants, Lions, Giraffes and Zebras from the surrounding Savannah plains. Leopards are also regularly spotted. The reserve is not particularly well – known and is therefore not too crowded – a huge plus in Kenya where so many reserves are often overflowing with tourists. It is often grouped together with the Buffalo Springs and Shaba National Reserves as they lie so close together.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dinner and overnight at Samburu Simba Lodge or similar</li> </ul>

4	SAMBURU ↓ ABERDARE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After breakfast, drive to Nyeri for lunch at Outspan Hotel.</li> <li>After lunch, you will be transferred in Hotel's vehicle to Treetops Lodge in Aberdare National Park. Treetops is famous because it is the place where Queen Elizabeth spent her night to wake up the next day to be pronounced the Queen of England.</li> <li>It overlooks floodlit water holes which attract teams of animals that visit the hole at night to drink water and lick salt. You will enjoy a night of game viewing from the Lodge's balcony. It will give you a chance of seeing the animals at close range. The Park has Elephants, Lions, Rhinos, Black Leopards and the beautiful but elusive Bongo Antelope.</li> <li>Dinner and overnight at Treetops Lodge or similar</li> </ul>

Lake Naivasha is a freshwater lake and is part of the Great Rift Valley. The name derives from the local Maasai name Nai'posha, meaning "rough water" because of the sudden storms which can arise. The lake is home to over 400 different species of birds. This freshwater lake is a bird-watcher's paradise. There is a sizeable population of Hippos in the lake. Along the lake's fabled waters, you are bound to see some of the area's more intriguing species—Hippos, Giraffes, Buffaloes and even the arboreal Colobus Monkey.</li> <li>▪ Floriculture forms the main industry around the lake. Dinner and overnight at Naivasha Simba Lodge or similar.</li> </ul>
